This year we will study the two letters that Paul penned to the first century Corinthian church some 25 years after the ascension of Jesus. These believers struggled with divisions, pride, lack of love and other maladies that sound similar to churches of our day! We can't help but see much polarization and hostility to the Truth of Scripture all around us, along with poor growth in grace or understanding of the Bible within the contemporary church. At the heart of these letters is the reality of the cross and the



resurrection, as Paul encouraged this church to return to the real Gospel of Grace. Unity of believers was paramount to Paul, grounded in Truth and bound together in Love. Our focus will be to meditate on and pray over the Word of God in these letters. Our text will be the Bible. Our hope rests in the Holy Spirit to “enlighten the eyes of our hearts” as we seek to link and apply the Whole Counsel of God to the study of these letters. Come join us!




The Books of Colossians and Philemon



I Samuel: At His Feet Studies by Hope A. Blanton & Christine B. Gordon



The geography, the year, and the culture have changed, but our God who sovereignly governs all creatures, nations, places, and events has not. As we study 1 Samuel together, we will learn of God's character, his lovingkindness, his provision, his discipline, and his protection of his people, which never fail. Written by two PCA ministry women, each of the 15-lessons offers a short commentary, 3 observation and 5 reflection questions to help apply the text. Our study of the stories of Hannah, Abigail and David is a study of our God, of his care for us, and of his never changing character.
